## While You Are There

Trash: all trash shall be carried out with you at the end of your stay.

Linens: Bring your own sheets and towels

**Cleaning:** You are responsible for leaving the house clean.

Electricity: Be sure that all the lights are off when you leave

Internet: ssid: ManyCousins, pwd:jfjmjfjm

**Food:** If your stay is during a period when other family groups will follow your stay then the refrigerator can stay on and you can leave (only good and fresh) food in it. Otherwise empty and clean the refrigerator.

Floating things: pull up all kayaks, boats and floating things.

**Outdoor furniture:** Organize the furniture out of the way so the lawn can get mowed.
